Admission Requirements:

- 19 years of age or older
- Ontario Secondary School Diploma (or equivalent) **with** Grade 12 English (E/C/U) Level.
OR
- Successful completion of the Mature Student Testing or General Education Development Test (GED).
OR
- appropriate credits from the Academic and Career Entrance (ACE) program - LBS level 5 Communications and LBS level 4 Mathematics.

Training Includes:

- 6 weeks training – Virtual class with 2 days (in-person) kitchen labs
- Communication and the Food Service Worker
- Institutional Food Service
- Sanitation and Safety
- Intro to Nutrition
- Nutrition in Health Care
- Quantity Food Preparation

- Safe Food Handling Certificate
- WHMIS Certificate
- Certificate of Recognition and Completion from Confederation College
