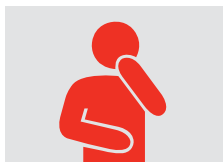
Chest discomfort



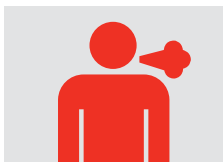
Sweating



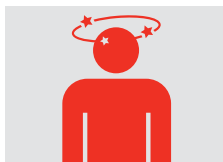
Upper body discomfort
