**TAKE NOTICE** that a Ratification Vote will be held in accordance with the Bingwi Neyaashi Anishinaabek Community Ratification Process on August 8<sup>th</sup>, 2015 in order to determine if Eligible Voters approve the *Bingwi Neyaashi Anishinaabek Matrimonial Real Property (MRP)*.

The following question will be asked of the Eligible Voters of Bingwi Neyaashi Anishinaabek by ballot:

**"Do you approve:**

- **The Bingwi Neyaashi Anishinaabek MRP Law, dated June 19, 2015.**

The Official Day for the Ratification Vote will take place on Saturday the 8<sup>th</sup> day/s of August, 2015 from 10:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. at:


