JOB DESCRIPTION AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Sawmill Worker will be working as a Sawyers Helper in the Papasay sawmill. While the Sawyer is responsible for those aspects of production which directly involve the the operation of the sawmill, the Sawyers Helper will be responsible for any and all supporting functions. This can include, but are not limited to:

- Training on and operation of equipment for the transportation of logs and milled timbers
- Assisting in the production, fulfillment, storage, loading, and transportation of orders
- Care and maintenance of production equipment and transportation equipment
- Snow removal and yard organization
- Operation of physical plant e.g. the boiler heating system
- Active contribution to a safe workplace: keeping a clean working environment and communicating concerns or observations to superiors

QUALIFICATIONS

- Any experience operating a sawmill is considered an asset
- Safety-conscious
- Posses a valid 'G' license and the means of transportation

HOURS AND COMPENSATION

Full-time position to start. Salary commensurate with experience. Pay raises available as expeirence is gained

The successful applicant will be working at PVAWP so we are searching for residents who live in the surrounding area and have a reliable means of transportation to get to the mill site at 1001 Copper Thunderbird Rd, Sandpoint FN, ON.
